

Enabling the QUERTY keyboard in Studio One

To record yourself playing a software instrument in Studio One, you need either an external MIDI keyboard plugged in, or Qwerty Keyboard on your computer screen, that you can play with your... well, Qwerty computer keyboard!

Go to **Song > Song Setup**.

Choose **Preferences** (a button below)


Choose **External Devices** (an icon above)

Choose **Add** (a button below)

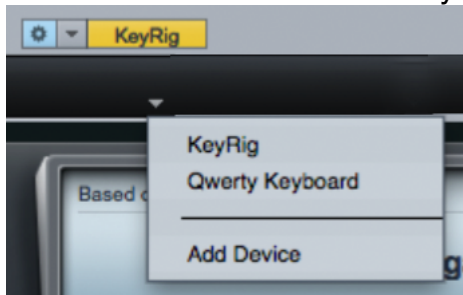
Scroll down through the list until you get to **PreSonus**.

Open the Presonus folder and select the **Qwerty Keyboard** option. Click **OK**, and Close Song Setup.

Open the Presence plugin. Playing the attached keyboard with produce sound, but playing it this way will not work for recording.

Press the little tools button  "round gear" which will drop down an options ribbon...

Click the **down arrow** to show you the options available.



Choosing the Qwerty keyboard will bring the Qwerty window up.

To record what you play – now you can press the record button in Studio One
As you play, a MIDI event will be recorded in the track that you can then edit further.
