

1. What are the first steps in starting a new project in Dreamweaver?

**Create a local directory.  
Use Site > New Site and specify what the root directory will be.  
Then start your first page.**

2. How do you tell Dreamweaver that you want to start an external CSS style sheet? (There are a couple steps.)

**In the CSS panel, choose New from the drop-down menu.  
Then choose the External option.  
Then you will be asked to name the external css file and specify a location for it.  
(Then create the style.)**

3. In Dreamweaver, what is the difference between Block and Box properties?

**Block are paragraph related.  
Box are DIV related, including margins, padding, size and float.**

4. What are three ways in Dreamweaver to apply a style, that already has been defined, to an element in the web page?

**Select the element in the design view, and use the Property panel drop-down.  
Select the element in the design view, and Right-click and choose CSS.  
Select the element in the code view, and Right-click and choose CSS.  
Type a class="style1" in the opening container tag in the code view.**

5. Describe two basic ways to make a graphic-based rollover with CSS. In other words, what actually is happening?

Way 1            **Make the badground image the rollover state, and make the foreground imagedisappear on a:hover**

Way 2            **Make the background a composite image with both states, and move a new portion of the background into view on a:hover**

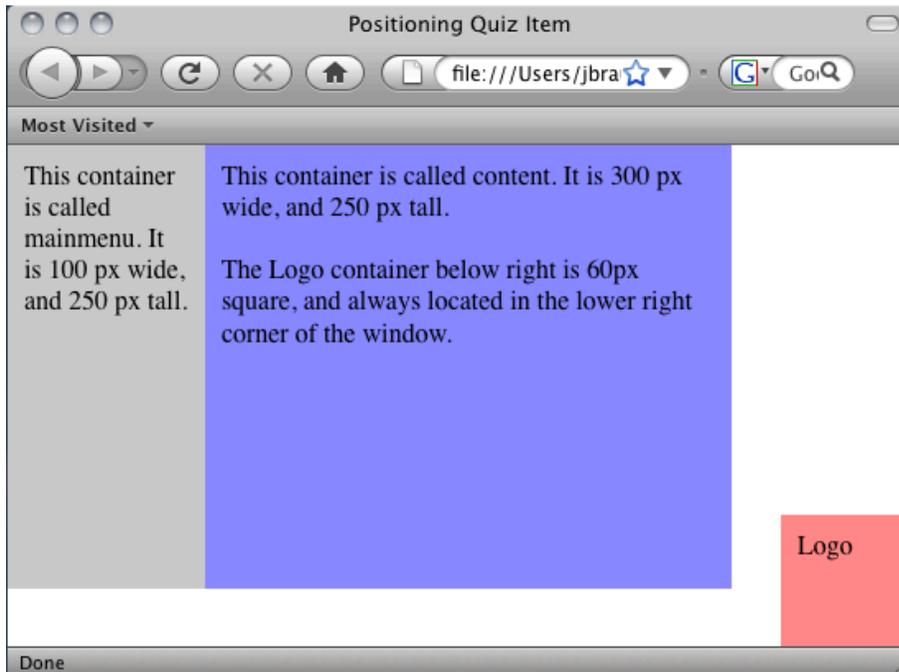
